ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTATION CHECKLIST

If you are selected to participate in the program through the random selection process and eligibility determination, you must bring documentation with you to your interview appointment to complete the eligibility process. The documentation provided must be current (on the date of application and/or within three months prior to the appointment), whichever applies.

VERY IMPORTANT

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- You must bring all the documentation that applies to you to the interview appointment.
- If you are under 18, a parent/guardian must attend the interview and eligibility appointment.
- **If you do not, the interview will not be held and will be rescheduled.**
- The application must be signed and dated by **the applicant, and parent or legal guardian where applicable.**
- Complete all areas. **If the application is NOT completely filled out, it will NOT be accepted.**

1. You must bring Income Verification documentation for the last six months - Pay Stubs, Bank Statements, Social Security Benefits (Retirement), Public Assistance Records, Alimony, Family/Business Financial Records, etc. (A family of 5 individuals living in a residence cannot make more than \$30,285 annually to be eligible for the program.)

2. If selected, bring these documents to the interview appointment:

- State Issued Driver's License or State ID Card
- School ID with Picture, if in high school, vocational or post-secondary education
- U.S. Social Security Card or Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
- Birth Certificate
- High School Diploma/GED Certificate or High School Transcripts

If you do not have the above documents, you must prove Right to Work. Please discuss during the initial phone call when scheduling an eligibility appointment.

Applications will be available at the following sites starting April 5th, 2010. Applications will need to be either submitted online or delivered to the following locations by 5:00 p.m. on May 7th, 2010 to be considered for the random selection process.
